The most expensive Brooklyn homes for sale

While less expensive than their Manhattan counterparts, these homes are still plenty pricey

As real estate prices throughout New York City climb ever-higher, seeing homes in Brooklyn listed in the millions of dollars has become, frankly, pretty normal. The borough's <u>most expensive home</u> sold for \$15.5 million in the summer of 2015, and just recently, <u>a condo sold for \$15 million</u>, showing that the borough's real estate market isn't slowing down.

And as of right now, there are plenty of properties on the market that are hovering around that number—and some that could even shatter that record if the right buyer comes along.

So with that in mind, here are Brooklyn's 20 priciest properties for sale right now—some have languished on the market for years, while others are newer entrants. And though they're not *as* ridiculously expensive as their <u>Manhattan counterparts</u>, suffice to say, they're all over-the-top.

16 98 Amity Street

\$8,400,000

The townhouse at <u>98 Amity Street</u> is part of the erstwhile <u>Long Island College</u> <u>Hospital</u> development, which was <u>recently rechristened River Park</u>. This particular 20-foot-wide townhouse is part of a grouping of eight houses, rising next to the landmarked Polhemus Building on Amity Street. It comes with a great room with 20-foot ceilings and a two-story window wall overlooking the garden; an optional mezzanine-level built-in marble and oak bar; and a full-floor master suite with a "master bath experience" including a soaking tub, two double showers, and a 17-foot dressing room. The price? <u>A cool \$8.4 million</u>.
